

JEE 2010 - RECEIVING DDs AND ACCEPTANCE LETTERS IN PRESCRIBED FORM FROM CANDIDATES AT IITH

Period **9th to 12th July 2010 (on all four days)** Time **1000 hrs to 1600 hrs**
Venue IIT building, near OFIL in the Ordnance Factory estate

Instructions to the candidates

- (a) Admit card and allotment letter to be brought for identification
- (b) DD should be in the name of CHAIRMAN JEE IIT MADRAS payable at Chennai
- (c) Amount of DD should be Rs. 40,000/- for GE/OBC candidates and Rs. 20,000/- for SC/ST/PD candidates
- (d) Name, Regn No. and AIR should be written by the candidate on the reverse of DD
- (e) Two copies of acceptance letters in prescribed format duly signed both by the candidate and his/her parent/guardian to be handed over alongwith DD
- (f) One copy of the acceptance letter to be taken back as acknowledgement from the Institute after ensuring that Officer in Charge of the Institute has signed the acknowledgement and seal of the Institute has been affixed over the acknowledgement copy by the documents receiving official of the Institute.

Location and how to reach IITH

IITH is located in Ordnance Factory Estate (ODF), 55 kms from Secunderabad/Hyderabad, 15/20 kms away from Patancheru and 6 kms from Shankarapally Rly.Stn.

By train - Train facility is available from Secunderabad and Hyderabad in the early morning hours upto Shankarapally from where bus/auto facility is available to the Institute. MMTS train from Secunderabad/Hyderabad to Lingampally Rly. Station from where auto/bus facility to ODF via BHEL gate, Patancheru, distance from Lingampally Rly station to IITH(ODF Estate) is 25 kms.

By Bus - Bus numbers 219 and 226 from Secunderabad to Patancheru and bus numbers 218 and 225 from Koti to Patancheru. From Patancheru to change bus to ODF(Ordnance Factory estate), to get down at bus stop nearer to the Institute in front of OFIL in the ODF estate.

By road - (a) **Via Patancheru** - Candidates desiring to reach the IITH by road in four wheeler/auto from Hyderabad/Secunderabad are required to travel another 5 kms on the National High Way towards Pune/Bombay from Patancheru upto Isnapur village where turn to left side is to be taken, to travel through Pashamylaram industrial estate to ODF estate (8 kms from Isnapur to ODF estate) and come to IITH in the ODF estate (to enter the estate through checkpost north – east side of the estate and after entering into the estate to travel about 2 kms towards South side to reach the IITH). (b) **Via: Ring Road from airport and Shankarapally** - Take left turn near Narsing(Hyd - Shankarpally high way road, then right turn at Gandipet junction and again right turn at Shankarpally to reach ODF estate, after entering estate through south side check post, at second island, take right turn to reach IIT on left side in front of OFIL hostel.

Coming from Sangareddy direction - On National High way from Pune to Hyderabad, after Sangareddy cross roads, to travel about 2 kms to Kandi village where turn to right side is to be taken towards Ordnance Factory about 8 – 10 kms from Kandi village to Ordnance Factory, further to travel south side and along the factory perimeter wall and

½ km ahead of Tower/South checkpost to take left turn to reach IITH located nearby in front of OFIL (bus and auto service is limited in this route).

SEAT ALLOTMENT

First Allotment

First allotment of seats will be declared on JEE websites of all IITs on 28th June 2010. These candidates will have to pay a Registration Fee to confirm the seat allotted to him/her. This amount (Rs.20,000 for SC/ST candidates and Rs.40,000 for others) will have to be paid in the form of a Demand Draft in favour of the "Chairman JEE, IIT Madras" payable at Chennai. Make sure to write your registration no. and name on the reverse side of the DD.

This payment must be made during 9th to 12th July, 2010 (between 10 am and 4 pm) by visiting **any of the following IITs**: Bhubaneswar, Bombay, Delhi, Guwahati, Hyderabad, Kanpur, Kharagpur, Madras, Patna, Rajasthan, Ropar, Roorkee, IT-BHU Varanasi or ISM Dhanbad and obtaining an official receipt. This amount will be adjusted towards the fee to be paid at the time of admission.

While submitting this fee the candidate will be asked to exercise an option for the second allotment.

He/she can opt for any one of the following:

Option 1: I do not want to participate in the second allotment as I am satisfied with the course allotted to me in the first allotment itself;

Option 2: I may be considered for second allotment to any other course in my choice sheet in order of priority only at the same institute where I have got my first allotment. I understand that if I am allotted a seat of higher preference as per my choice sheet through second allotment, my seat through first allotment stands cancelled.

Option 3: I may be considered for second allotment for any course in my choice sheet in order of priority across any of the institutes. I understand that if I am allotted a seat of higher preference as per my choice sheet through second allotment, my seat through first allotment stands cancelled.
