- Q. Are there any laws/policies enforced against ragging at IIT Hyderabad?
A. There is a no-ragging policy at IIT Hyderabad. Each student was made to sign an anti-ragging pact last year to protect all students of IIT Hyderabad. All matters of ragging are taken very seriously at the Institute and if any student is found guilty of ragging, he/she will be subjected to strong discipline actions. Also, any student can call 9491040806 anytime if they feel they have been a subject of ragging and want to talk to someone or file a complaint. - Q. In what way is IIT Madras associated with IIT Hyderabad?
A. IITM is the mentor institute. IITH follows a similar curriculum as that of IITM. As of now, some of the faculty at IITM will be teaching courses at IITH.
- Q. Does IIT Hyderabad have permanent faculty to teach courses at the Institute?
A. Currently, faculty recruitment is in progress. It is expected to have permanent faculty by January 2010. As of now, the faculty from IIT Madras and some renowned visiting faculty from the city of Hyderabad will be taking teaching courses at the Institute for the present semester (August-December 2009).
- Q. What about laboratories and workshops at IIT Hyderabad?
A. The laboratories and workshops are all set up to meet the needs of all first year B.tech students. Labs and workshops for the 2nd year students are currently being built.
- Q. How are the hostels at IIT Hyderabad?
A. All hostels at IITH are well equipped with room furniture. Each room is shared with two students and has 2 desks, 2 almira's and 2 beds. Mattresses/ pillows for the beds need to be brought by the students or can be purchased at the time of check-in. All hostels have well maintained bathroom facilities. Buckets, Mugs etc. again need to be brought by the students or can be purchased by the vendors at check-in. Each hostel has amenities such as a TV room, game room, study room and a computer room. Students can also request their rooms to be cleaned on a daily/ weekly basis if they choose to do so.
- Q. How is the food at IIT Hyderabad?
A. IIT Hyderabad's Dining Hall provides healthy and hygienic food for all students. There is a Dining Hall committee comprised of students to look after the menu and food quality.
- Q. What is the climate like in Hyderabad?
A. It is usually very hot and dry (35-38 degrees) during the summer (April and May). It rains quite a lot in the months of July and August but gets a little cold (25-30 degrees) during the winter months (November-February).
- Q. Are students allowed to leave campus while at the Institute?
A. Students can leave campus if they choose to do so. They have to sign in at a register maintained at the hostels before leaving during weekends. In case the student wants to leave during weekdays he/she has to take permission from the Institute.

Q. When can we expect to move to the permanent campus?

A. The Master plan for the permanent campus is ready and students are expected to start moving to the new campus by 2010.

Q. Are students allowed to use electronic devices like water heaters, coolers etc. in their rooms?

A. IIT Hyderabad strictly prohibits the use of such devices on campus and in the hostels because of safety reasons.
