Presentation Rule:

- 3. If you are presenting Journal paper, you have to circulate it to group at least 1 week advance.
- 4. You HAVE to PRESENT on your scheduled date. If you cannot present in your slot, this is your responsibility to find other people to present in your slot.
- 5. Monthly Review meeting should contain what you did during the entire month and what is your plan in the next months.
