Instructions to the Candidates attending the Written/Skill test on <u>12 & 13 March 2022</u>

- 1. The candidate must reach the exam center(Academic Block-C, IIT Hyderabad campus) by 07:45 AM on the date of exam along with the Email copy of the call letter.
- 2. The candidates are required to produce an original valid photo Identity Card, Original educational qualification certificates, experience certificates and category certificate(if applicable) for verification without which the candidate will not be allowed inside the examination hall. No other person will be allowed inside the campus except the candidate.
- 3. Candidates, who are in the service of Government, Semi-Government/ PSUs, Central or State Autonomous bodies, Corporations should bring 'No Objection Certificate' from their present employer and submit it at the verification counter, failing which the Candidates will not be allowed to appear for the exam. NOC must be produced even if the candidate has joined the employment of Government/ Semi-Government/ Autonomous Bodies/PSU, after applying for IIT Hyderabad.
- 4. Self-driven vehicles will have to be parked at the main gate parking area. No parking of vehicles is permitted near the exam venue. Candidates may use the Institute transportation facilities for commutation from the main gate parking area to the exam venue of Academic Block C.
- 5. Candidates should **mandatorily wear masks** and are advised to carry personal sanitizers and water bottles.
- 6. The written test is OMR based.
- 7. All the candidates should mandatorily carry a **Black Ball Point pen** to mark their responses in OMR Sheet.
- 8. Candidates are NOT allowed to carry any personal belongings like electronic devices, mobile phones etc. to the Examination Centre.
- 9. All Candidates are advised to make their own lunch arrangements. If required, Lunch is provided at the designated place/counter on payment basis.
- 10. No candidate shall be permitted to enter after the Gate Closing Time i.e. 8:45 AM . The candidates will not be allowed to leave the examination till closing time of the examination.
- 11. There maybe a requirement to stay on till 5pm on the examination day, hence it is requested to make your own logistics arrangements
- 12. Candidates are advised to strictly adhere to the COVID-19 guidelines.
- 13. Candidates are advised to check updates on the Institute website regularly.
