Reply:

- 1. Providing recorded video clips of lectures for the convenience of students.
- 2.Faculty have been sensitised towards the special needs of PwD students. IITH has gone for progressive evaluation model wherein students are awarded grades based on their performance throughout the year and not just the final exams.
- 3.Lab courses have been postponed in view of the pandemic. In some cases where necessary, virtual labs were arranged.
