The applicant made multiple applications more or less with similar kind of questions. Apart from RTIs the applicant also sent multiple emails, of which the Institute replied to a good number of emails.

	12)How many unfair recruitments/ re-examinations are conducted by IIT-H till dates provide me the list. Thanking you. With regards, shravan kumar	

Grounds of the appeal:

Provided Incomplete, Misleading or False Information

Appeal Text:

1) Different kinds of questions were asked with different RTI applications, CPIO should understand this.

- 2) The questions asked through emails is also different and on different subject,(regarding selection of candidature) which is extraneous to present RTI application.
- 3) It is evident from earlier RTI applications (Nos:114 and 126) that,CPIO is providing improper information to us all the times, by saying questions are hypothetical nature. Most of the information provided by CPIO is updated/modified/provided by Registrar the first appellate authority.
- 4) Because of these improper replies from CPIO We have to wait for one more month for seeking information by raising it to first appellate authority.
- 5) In view of the above, Kindly provide the information for the points asked by me for 3 to 12 in my RTI application please.

Disposal of Appeal:

1. **Q.No. 3)** Whether reservations applicable to jobs as per GOI are followed by IIT-H in its recruitments till the selection process?

Reply: The Institute follows the GoI norms in providing reservations to the job applicants.

Q.No. 4) If Govt of India rules followed by IIT-H from time to time, kindly provide the list of cases in which prima facie proof caste certificates accepted by IIT-H till date in your recruitments.

Reply: The question is not clear. However, it is to inform that the Institute accepts the caste certificates in the format prescribed by the Govt. of India.

For the Q.Nos 5) to 12):

Reply: Answers provided by the CPIO stands good.
