Kindly do reply us.</p>	<p>All the relevant documents & information pertaining to the installation of the subject equipment has already been shared with you vide your RTI application nos. IITHY/R/2018/50005 dt 19/01/2018 as , and IITHY/R/E/22/00025 dt 22/03/2022 and this Institute's replier thereto.</p> <p>As per the information contained in the records held by this Institute, it is noticed that you had earlier represented demanding the same information. Your representation was examined by the Technical Evaluation Committee and a suitable reply was already given to you, vide the Institute's email dt.18/01/2018 (3:07 PM). Subsequently also, you had filed an application under the RTI Act and sought the same information. The Institute provided the available information to you in response to your aforesaid RTI, vide this Institute's letter dt.13/04/2018 (copy attached again for ready reference). Again, you had filed another application under RTI Act in March 2022 and asker for the installation report which was provided to you, vide Institute's reply dt.11.03.2022(copy attached for ready references annexure-l).</p>

		Yet again, you have filed two applications (IITHY/R/E/22/00049,50,51,&52) in May '22, including this one under RTI seeking the same information. The Institute has already furnished the available information in response to your several previous requests. The Technical Committee has found the equipment procured through the said Tendering process meets all the technical specifications required and notified in the Tender Document. There is no other fresh information to furnish on the same in the records held by this Institute.

Grounds of the appeal:

Provided Incomplete, Misleading or False Information

Appeal Text:

Dear Sir,

As per RTI reply : IITH/40/R/2022/RTI/MS dated 13.06.2022, I could not find any supporting document/ information regarding the delivered high-speed laser by L1 bidder. RTI Applications: IITHY/R/E/22/00049,50,51&52 all happened because of a technical fault while submission.

I am asking the same queries since 2018. For your information, RTI Appeal: IITHY/A/2018/60016 dated 02.04.2018. But till now IITHyderabad was unable to provide the requested information about the supplied/delivered Laser.

Regarding the tender no: IITH-JICA/CHE/KSAHU/2017/T092, the system was supplied and installed at the institute by the L1 bidder. As we are an L2 bidder, please do provide us with the document forth installed YLF30-1000-LIT laser system that has monolithic dual cavity laser heads and can be operated from a Single shot (as per the tender specification).

Disposal of Appeal:

1. It is observed that CPIO has already furnished the eligible information and the information is neither incomplete nor false. There is no merit in the grounds of this appeal. It is already made clear in the RTI request that no fresh information is available to furnish.
2. Further, this is to inform you that the RTI is meant to furnish Information and it is not a grievance redressal mechanism that can settle disputes. Therefore, it is expected from the applicant that he/she should only seek information as it has been defined under the RTI Act and not ask for solutions of problems, disputes, reasons for someone's appointment etc.
