Following terms and conditions supersede all existing "Buyer added Bid Specific Terms and conditions" given in the bid document or any previous corrigendum. Prospective bidders are advised to bid as per following Terms and Conditions:

Buyer Added Bid Specific Additional Terms and Conditions

1. OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity by up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. Bidders are bound to accept the orders accordingly.
2. Buyer Added text based ATC clauses
 1. Bidder should submit all the documents as per the uploaded buyer added ATC document.
 2. Price should be inclusive of all i.e supply , installation and other charges if any.

3. Terms and conditions for instruments

1. i) The supplier must provide installation, commission, and training for a group of technical staff/students from operating the instrument without any additional cost with supply of all the relevant manuals and documents in printed format.
2. ii) The supplier must demonstrate that they have appropriate set-up and capability to provide after-sales service within 48 hours from the communication effectively in India for prompt service support along with number of service engineers specially trained on the offered system.
3. iii) The supplier must provide detailed lists of Indian users for quoted/similar models and contact details. At least THREE purchase orders not older than 3 years from IITs/NITs/Central University/any other Govt organizations should be included with the technical bid. The performance certificate of quoted MFCs from Indian users should be included along with the technical bid.
4. iv) Necessary pre-installation advice should be provided along with technical bid.
5. iv) The calibration certificate with respective gasses should be provided along with MFCs during delivery.

1. Definition of Class I and Class II suppliers in the bid not in line with the extant Order / Office Memorandum issued by DPIIT in this regard.
2. Seeking EMD submission from bidder(s), including via Additional Terms & Conditions, in contravention to exemption provided to such sellers under GeM GTC.
3. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available without any Category item bunched with it.
4. Creating BoQ bid for single item.
5. Mentioning specific Brand or Make or Model or Manufacturer or Dealer name.
6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
7. Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.
8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process.
9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM.
