

General Instructions to the Candidate attending the Written/Skill test from 14 Dec 2020 to 18 Dec 2020:

All the shortlisted candidates for the different streams are hereby notified that:

1. As a precaution for COVID-19, the candidate must reach center as indicated against Reporting/Entry time at **center (2hrs before the commencement of the exam)**. Candidate should bring the **photo pasted candidate Admit Card cum Declaration form along with a valid photo ID Card and Covid-19 self-declaration form** without which the candidate will not be allowed inside the campus. No other person will be allowed inside the campus except the candidate.
2. Candidates, who are in the service of Government, Semi-Government / PSUs, should bring the Original '**No Objection Certificate**' from their present employer and submit it to the invigilator at the time of attending the Written Test, without which the Candidates will not be allowed to appear for the exam. NOC must be produced even if the candidate has joined the employment of Government/Semi-Government/Autonomous Bodies/PSU, after applying for IIT Hyderabad.
3. Private vehicles will be allowed to enter inside the campus till the exam venue. Self-driven vehicles will have to be parked at the main gate parking area. However, the vehicles will be routed to Main Gate parking area after the candidate is dropped. No parking of vehicles is permitted near the exam venue. Candidates may use the Institute transportation facilities for commutation from main gate parking area to the exam venue.
4. Candidates should **mandatorily wear mask** and are advised to carry their personal sanitizers and water bottles.
5. The exam is OMR based multiple choice exam (except Junior Hindi Translator).
6. All the candidates should mandatorily carry a **Black Ball Point pen** to mark their responses in OMR Sheet. No pens will be provided by the Institute.
7. Candidates are NOT allowed to carry any personal belongings including electronic devices, mobile phone and other banned/ prohibited to the Examination Centre.
8. All Candidates (except the ones attending trade/skill test and written test in two different (F/N & A/N) sessions) are advised to make their own lunch arrangements.
9. All candidates will be checked at the reception area for temperature and symptoms related to Covid-19.
10. No candidate shall be permitted to enter after the Gate Closing Time i.e. commencement time of the exam as communicated to the candidates.
11. Candidates are advised to strictly adhere to the COVID-19 New normal guidelines issued by the MHA, GoI from time to time.
12. Candidates are advised to check updates on the Institute website regularly.
