Job Responsibilities:

Candidate would be responsible for leading the Program operations and overseeing the activities and overall administration of the Program and reporting to Faculty-in-Charge of TBI

- Augment the partnership between NMDC and i-TIC Foundation by leveraging the resources of both the organizations for the benefit of the program.
- Planning and executing the Fellowship program under NICE
- Create a strong network and a pipeline for the Fellowship and Startup Programs, for long term sustainability of the NICE program
- Provide continued strategic guidance to entrepreneurs in areas such as business modeling, sales, and marketing, financing, fundraising, overall strategy, operations etc.
- Develop the mentor network for the Program and work with them to make the incubated startups successful
- Forge partnerships with other organizations for providing services to the Program; marketing, sponsorships, government and industries connects, etc. as per requirement
- Monitor and implement required statutory norms for grants management of Program
- Prepare and submit review documents of the Incubation program
- Represent NICE at various startup events, conferences, etc.
- Other responsibilities related to the incubation activities as assigned by Faculty-In-Charge TBI.
