	1. Complete list of students that have been offered admission to M.Des for the year 2021.	List attached as Annexure -I (as on date 25 th June 2021)
	2. Final cut off clearly mentioning the interview marks category wise for all the students that have been offered M.des admission provisionally.	The final CEED Cutoffs were earlier published on the department website. The same is attached here as Annexure-II. There was no interview conducted this time but only Design Aptitude Test (DAT) was conducted. 70% Weightage was given to the CEED score and 30% to the DAT. Final list mentioning the interview marks attached as Annexure-III.
	3. Why an institution like IIT Hyderabad is not providing the complete list of students on public domain, so that students may clearly know who have been selected at what rank with what score.	All the selected and waitlisted candidates have been informed through email. The names of the selected and waitlisted candidates are not provided openly in the public domain to maintain the privacy of the candidates.
	4. Why do IITs conduct an exam like CEED when they do not even want to publish results in public domain and thereby hampering the selection process of deserving candidates. Why so much of hidden ulterior motives behind discreet selection unlike other exams like JEE where marks ranks everything is disclosed to candidates.	1. CEED is a qualifying exam. 2. IITs/IISc do conduct their own Design Aptitude Tests and other procedures like interview to select the candidates. 3. IIT Hyderabad also conducts Design Aptitude Test for the shortlisted candidates based on the CEED Score, primarily to assess the suitability of the candidates for the M. Des. programme in the Design department. There are no ulterior motives. The ranks are already shared with the respective candidates. All Annexure are sent to registered mail ID.
