	1. What is the selection criteria for admission in detail?	Merit list is based on GATE score
	2. What is the minimum Cut-off for the said admission?	At the end of COAP and Spot round, the cut-off GATE score were 658 (UR), 556 (EWS), 579 (OBC), 326 (SC) for in M.Tech in Climate Change (CC).
	3. What is the status of My Application (My application No. is70316 and 82994)?	70316 had applied to Climate Change but did not meet the cutoff.
	4. Why admission portal removed from your website after the last date of submission of application? Due to this reason I amunable to Check the status of my application after submission.	After the submission of your application, all the applications are sent to different departments. Since the portal is not accessible by all the department, updating the status after every round is practically not possible. All the information are provided through COAP as we submit our list to them.
	5. Why there is no information regarding Minimum cut-off for admission in your website?	Minimum cut-off varies from year to year basis. It is difficult to predict such information for the current year admission. The information for previous year admissions are given as per the request.
	6. Why there is no information regarding last selected GATE score after completion of each rounds of COAP 2021 in your website?	Thanks for your advice. Since there are very few days left between each round it is practically not possible to do it. Since we provide all the information to COAP, we think such information should be matined by COAP on their website.
	7. How many number of candidates selected in each category in each stream?	Through COAP: 1 UR, 1 EWS, 1 OBC, and 1 SC. Additionally, 1 candidate was selected through self-sponsored stream.
	8. Is all seats published in notification were occupied?	3 seats were filled at the end of COAP rounds, 1 seat was filled through Spot rounds.
	9. How many rounds did IITH have participated in COAP2021?	All the 10 rounds of COAP and further a spot round was conducted to fill unfilled seats.
