For candidates with a PG degree, we kept the following cut-off CGPA for both (UG and PG) their degrees.</p> <p>-- both CGPAs are at least 7 and the best of the two CPGAs is CGPA 7.8 or above for General category</p> <p>-- both CGPAs are at least 6.3 and the best of the two CPGAs is 7.02 or above for OBC (Non creamy layer)</p> <p>-- both CGPAs are at least 5.9 and the best of the two CPGAs is 6.63 or above for SC/ST</p> <p>2.
