Instructions to the Bidders for Online Bid Submission

The bidders are required to submit soft copies of their bids electronically on the CPP Portal, using valid Digital Signature Certificates. The instructions given below are meant to assist the bidders in registering on the CPP Portal, preparing their bids in accordance with the requirements and submitting their bids online on the CPP Portal.

More information useful for submitting online bids on the CPP Portal may be obtained at: https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app.

REGISTRATION

- 1) Bidders are required to enroll on the e-Procurement module of the Central Public Procurement Portal (URL: https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app) by clicking on the link "Online bidder Enrollment" on the CPP Portal which is free of charge.
- 2) As part of the enrolment process, the bidders will be required to choose a unique username and assign a password for their accounts.
- 3) Bidders are advised to register their valid email addresses and mobile numbers as part of the registration process. These would be used for any communication from the CPP Portal.
- 4) Upon enrolment, the bidders will be required to register their valid Digital Signature Certificate (Class III Certificates with signing key usage) issued by any Certifying Authority recognized by CCA India (e.g. Sify / nCode / eMudhra etc.,), with their profile.
- 5) Only one valid DSC should be registered by a bidder. Please note that the bidders are responsible to ensure that they do not lend their DSC's to others which may lead to misuse.
- 6) Bidder then logs in to the site through the secured log-in by entering their user ID/password and the password of the DSC / e-Token.

SEARCHING FOR TENDER DOCUMENTS

- 1) There are various search options built in the CPP Portal, to facilitate bidders to search active tenders by several parameters. These parameters could include Tender ID, Organization Name, Location, Date, Value, etc. There is also an option of advanced search for tenders, wherein the bidders may combine a number of search parameters such as Organization Name, Form of Contract, Location, Date, Other keywords etc. to search for a tender published on the CPP Portal.
- 2) Once the bidders have selected the tenders they are interested in, they may download the required documents / tender schedules. These tenders can be moved to the respective 'My Tenders' folder. This would enable the CPP Portal to intimate the bidders through SMS / e- mail in case there is any corrigendum issued to the tender document.
- 3) The bidder should make a note of the unique Tender ID assigned to each tender, in case they want to obtain any clarification / help from the Helpdesk.

PREPARATION OF BIDS

- 1) Bidder should take into account any corrigendum published on the tender document before submitting their bids.
- 2) Please go through the tender advertisement and the tender document carefully to understand the documents required to be submitted as part of the bid. Please note the number of covers in which the bid documents have to be submitted, the number of documents including the names and content of each of the document that need to be submitted. Any deviations from these may lead to rejection of the bid.
- 3) Bidder, in advance, should get ready the bid documents to be submitted as indicated in the tender document/schedule and generally, they can be in PDF / XLS / RAR / DWF/JPG formats. Bid documents may be scanned with 100 dpi with black-and white option which helps in reducing the size of the scanned document.
- 4) To avoid the time and effort required in uploading the same set of standard documents which are required to be submitted as a part of every bid, a provision of uploading such standard documents (e.g. PAN card copy, annual reports, auditor certificates, etc.) has been provided to the bidders. Bidders can use the "My Space" or "Other Important Documents" are available to them to upload such documents. These documents may be directly submitted from the "My Space" area while submitting a bid, and need not be uploaded again and again. This will lead to a reduction in the time required for bid submission process.

SUBMISSION OF BIDS

- 5) Bidder should log into the site well in advance for bid submission.
- 6) ion so that they can upload the bid in time i.e., on or before the bid submission time. Bidder will be responsible for any delay due to other issues.
- 7) The bidder has to digitally sign and upload the required bid documents one by one as indicated in the tender document.
- 8) Bidder has to select the payment option as "offline" to pay the tender fee / EMD as applicable and enter details of the instrument.
- 9) Bidder should prepare the EMD as per the instructions specified in the tender document. The original should be posted/couriered/given in person to the concerned official, latest by the last date and time of bid submission or as specified in the tender documents. The details of the DD/any other accepted instrument, physically sent, should tally with the details available in the scanned copy and the data entered during bid submission time. Otherwise, the uploaded bid will be rejected.

- 10) Bidders are requested to note that they should necessarily submit their financial bids in the format provided and no other format is acceptable. If the price bid has been given as a standard BoQ format with the tender document, then the same is to be downloaded and to be filled by all the bidders. Bidders are required to download the BoQ file, open it and complete the white coloured (unprotected) cells with their respective financial quotes and other details (such as name of the bidder). No other cells should be changed. Once the details have been completed, the bidder should save it and submit it online, without changing the filename. If the BoQ file is found to be modified by the bidder, the bid will be rejected.
- 11) The server time (which is displayed on the bidders' dashboard) will be considered as the standard time for referencing the deadlines for submission of the bids by the bidders, opening of bids etc., The bidders should follow this time during bid submission.
- 12) All the documents being submitted by the bidders would be encrypted using PKI encryption techniques to ensure the secrecy of the data. The data entered cannot be viewed by unauthorized persons until the time of bid opening. The confidentiality of the bids is maintained using the secured Socket Layer 128-bit encryption technology. Data storage encryption of sensitive fields is done. Any bid document that is uploaded to the server is subjected to symmetric encryption using a system generated symmetric key. Further this key is subjected to asymmetric encryption using buyers/bid opener's public keys. Overall, the uploaded tender documents become readable only after the tender opening by the authorized bid openers.
- 13) The uploaded tender documents become readable only after the tender opening by the authorized bid openers.
- 14) Upon the successful and timely submission of bids (i.e., after Clicking "Freeze Bid Submission" in the portal), the portal will give a successful bid submission message & a bid summary will be displayed with the bid no. and the date & time of submission of the bid with all other relevant details.
- 15) The bid summary has to be printed and kept as an acknowledgement of the submission of the bid. This acknowledgement may be used as an entry pass for any bid opening meetings.

This vehicle should run within the IITH Campus overseeing the construction activities, purchase of petty materials from market at Isnapur, Sangareddy and nearby locations including Hyderabad. Liasoning with different external Government agencies/Departments in Sangareddy and nearby locations including Hyderabad Maintenance of residential and non-residential building of IITH Campus. The Construction and maintenance Department will coordinate the timings and issue necessary instructions from time to time.

- 2. The bidder should have all the requisite valid registration and Commercial vehicle licenses, Pollution and Insurance for providing the service.
- 3. The Contractor shall provide the vehicle on round the clock (24x7) basis with 01driver in each shift, totalling to 03drivers each 24hrs.day with 01additional reliever for providing a mandatory weekly off to the onduty drivers.
- 4. The contractor has to maintain attendance register for the deployed workers/drivers at IITH and shall maintain the same in a fair manner and shall submit the copy of same to the Engineer-in-Charge along with the monthly running bills.
- 5. In case of any shortfall of the driver strength by the contractor, the same shall be recoverable from the contractor monthly running bills and the Engineer-in-Charge at it's discretion may deploy the shorfall strength from third party at the risk and cost of the contractor.
- 6. The contractor shall pay to the deployed drivers the monthly salary based on the Minimum Wages Order of Chief Labour Commissioner(CLC), Govt. Of India under semi-skilled category and proof of such payment of wages to the drivers shall be submitted by the contractor along with his monthly bills.
- 7. The provisions of EPF and ESIC act shall also be mandatory complied by the contractor and such facilities shall be invariably passed on to the drivers deployed on this work. The Proof of same shall also be submitted by the contractor along with his monthly bills.
- 8. On receipt of above mandatory documents only by the contractor to IITH, the monthly bills will be processed for further payment by IITH.
- 9. The person deployed for work should not be involved in any police case or any case should not be pending against them. The Police clearance certificate shall be submitted by the contractor to IITH for the drivers to be deployed on site.
- 10. The drivers must be having valid Driving license of suitable vehicle category for which they are to be deployed at IITH.
- 11.In case of any break-down/maintenance shutdown of the deployed vehicle at IITH, the contractor has to immediately provide replacement with alternate vehicle within a maximum of 03-04hrs.time till the time original vehicle is repaired and put to service again. The contractor has to maintain the deployed vehicle in good working condition on all service days.
- 12.In no case, the essential services vehicle shall be removed by the contractor or not to be shutdown without the permission of Engineer-in-Charge.
- 13. The contractor shall be fully responsible to maintain minimum 80% reserve capacity of Diesel in the fuel

tank of deployed vehicle. In case of non-filling of Diesel by the contractor, the IITH authority may get it filled at the risk and cost of the contractor and the same recovery may be done from the monthly running bills of the contractor.

- 14. The contractor's drivers have to maintain a proper printed Log books of the deployed vehicle and everyday running kms. shall be entered in such log-books and to be get countersigned from IITH staff. The contractor shall produce and submit copies of such Log-books along with his monthly running bills.
- 15. The workers must be provided with uniform-02sets (and where required shoes-01set and other materials for safety and safe operations) by the contractor from out of his quoted rates only. The workers should maintain personal hygiene. They should behave politely and amenable to discipline.
- 16.If in the opinion of the IITH authorities, the performance of any of the person deployed is not satisfactory or he is not amenable to discipline or their behavior is not conductive to retain them for the work, he should be replaced immediately within a maximum of 24hrs. of time.
- 17. The vehicle movement required beyond campus for goods/Staff transport.
- 18.If Vehicle is not available in any circumstances beyond 4 hours on any day, recovery will be on pro-rata basis.
- 19. Damages of vehicle in any situation is not attributed to IITH.
- 20. Vehicle shall be maintained in good worthy condition.
- 21. The standard GCC for maintenance works shall be refereed to and applicable to this work at the discretion of IIT Hyderabad.
- 22. Contract agreement shall be drawn with the successful bidder on submission of Performance Guarantee.
- 23. The model/Engine of the vehicle shall not be older than the year 2023 and shall be complying to latest emission norms as applicable and acceptable as per Govt guidelines.
- 24. As the scope vehicle comes under the essential services of IITH, in case of non-availability/non-deployment of vehicle on any single day by the contractor at CMD, IITH then at it's dicretion the Engineer-in-Charge may either deduct the proportionate vehicle charges from the contractor's running bills or may deploy immediately another equivalent vehicle from outside third party at the risk and cost of contractor till the time the original vehicle is restored by the contractor to IITH.
- 25. At the discretion of IITH, the tenure of this work may be extended further after Original completion date **for a period of 06months to 01year** on the same rates, terms and conditions as in the original contract agreement.
- 26. The Executive Engineer-Electrical, IIT Hyderabad shall be the Engineer-in-Charge for the execution of this work.
- 27. Any other important instructions given by the Engineer-in-Charge to the contractor in order to ensure smooth and disciplined operation of deployed vehicle services to IITH.
